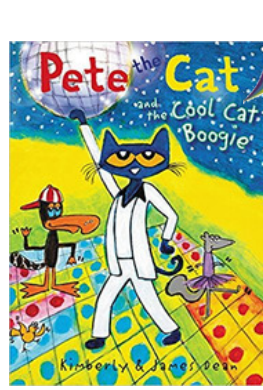
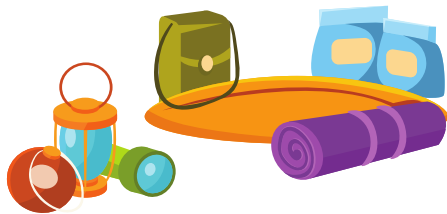

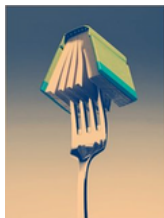
## KINDERGARTEN - GRADE 5

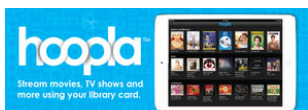
