Activation Instructions for In-Library/Web-Only Access

Here are user-friendly instructions for your library patrons to activate their New York Times access.

As a Public Library patron, you have free access to The New York Times! Get started today by following these simple steps to activate your New York Times access:

While onsite at the library:

1. Ensure you are using the library's Wi-Fi connection.
2. Visit [nytimes.com](https://www.nytimes.com) using any device.
3. Go to the upper right-hand corner of the screen. Click on "Log in" to create a free account or log in to your existing account.*
4. You now have full access to all news journalism on nytimes.com while logged in at the library.

Note: The New York Times app is not included as part of the onsite experience.

While using Web-Only access for All Access, select games are not available, including The Mini, Tiles, Letterboxed, and the Games archive.

*Some accounts may not require user registration.
